**PUBLIC SPEAKING – INTERMEDIATE**

**Course Description:**

This course aims to improve the effectiveness and fluency of the participants' English oral communication skills by providing instruction and experience in preparation and delivery of speeches within a variety of public speaking settings and group discussions. Throughout the course, participants will present a number of individual speeches (self-introduction, narrative, persuasive, and special occasion speech) that seek to develop and enhance these skills through special emphasis on research, preparation, delivery and critical thinking. Upon completion, participants should be able to prepare and deliver well-organized speeches and participate in group discussions with appropriate multimedia support. Participants should also demonstrate the speaking, listening, and interpersonal skills necessary to be effective communicators in academic settings, in the workplace, and in the community.
